46 TOTAL RESPONSES, 52% FROM THE U.S.

- MOST RESPONDENTS (70%) REPORTED THAT THEY DID NOT RECEIVE DIRECT GOVERNMENT SUBSIDIES.
- MOST RESPONDENTS (77%) REPORTED THAT THEY DO NOT BELIEVE THAT GOVERNMENT SUBSIDIES ARE NECESSARY FOR RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT.
- RESPONDENTS WERE NEARLY EVENLY SPLIT IN PREFERRING NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS ADOPT A COMPLETE HANDS-OFF APPROACH TO THE PULP AND PAPER INDUSTRY; PROVIDE RESEARCH MONIES TO UNIVERSITIES AND OTHER RESEARCH CENTERS; OR PROVIDE TAX BREAKS AND TARIFF HELP TO THE PULP AND PAPER INDUSTRY
